

...MIDDLE SCHOOL DRESS CODE...

2010-2011

Girls...

- Blouses: collared solid white or light blue
- Sweater: navy blue or burgundy
- Sweatshirt: navy blue, green, gray, burgundy, or white with St. Patrick logo or any other sweatshirt purchased through the school (sweatshirts may not be worn without a uniform shirt/blouse underneath)
- Polo shirts: white, navy blue, green, or burgundy with or without St. Patrick logo
- Turtleneck: white
- Skirt/Culottes: navy blue
- Slacks: cords – navy blue or khaki (tan); Knits – navy blue; Chinos – navy blue or khaki (tan)
- Walking shorts: navy blue or khaki (tan)
- Belt: must be worn if slacks/shorts have belt loops

- All blouses are to be tucked in. Uniform blouses or turtlenecks must be worn under sweatshirts.
- All shoes are to be laced up and tied. Anklets, crew, or tube socks are required. Sandals must be worn with socks except on out of uniform days.
- Earrings are acceptable for girls only --- no nose rings, eyebrow rings, etc. are allowed.
- *All skirts/shorts are to adhere to the official uniform as sold by Carpenter Uniform Company. These will be the rule of measurement and fabric. Oversize or baggy shorts or pants are not allowed.*
- Walking shorts may only be worn from August to October 15th and from April 15th to the end of the school year.
- No coats or hooded sweatshirts are to be worn during school hours.

Boys...

- Shirt: solid white, light blue, or blue and white pinstripe with collar
- Polo shirt: white, light blue, navy blue, green, or burgundy with or without St. Patrick logo
- Sweater: navy blue or burgundy

- Sweatshirt: navy blue, burgundy, gray, green, or white with St. Patrick logo or any other St. Patrick sweatshirt purchased through the school
 - Slacks: Cords – navy blue or khaki (tan); Chinos – navy blue or khaki (tan)
 - Walking shorts: navy blue or khaki (tan)
 - Belts: Must be worn if slacks/shorts have belt loops
- All shirts are to be tucked in. Uniform shirts must be worn under sweatshirts.
 - All shoes are to be laced up and tied. Anklets, crew, or tube socks are required. Sandals must be worn with socks except on out of uniform days.
 - Boys will not be allowed to wear earrings, nose rings, eyebrow rings, etc. while at school.
 - *All shorts are to adhere to the official uniform as sold by Carpenter Uniform Company. These will be the rule of measurement and fabric. Oversize or baggy shorts or pants are not allowed.*
 - Walking shorts may only be worn from August to October 15th and from April 15th to the end of the school year.
 - No coats or hooded sweatshirts are to be worn during school hours.
 - The hair length for boys shall be no longer than the bottom of the shirt collar. It shall be clean, styled, and combed.
